**Reports:**

- STARS Update: New version of SAS will soon be used for running STARS – will not affect the hospitals, but will make the work easier for CHD staff.
- EMS/ FirstWatch: Upgraded ambulance CAD, which will increase the information available to the viewer.
- Treasurer Report: No update.

**Old Business:**

- NIMS:

  - VA Hospital under mandate to complete training as well.
- UASI Projects:
  - Pharmaceutical cache reduced to an amount that would not provide meds for a sufficient number of people so the project was withdrawn.
  - \$500,000 in lockdown project has already been approved by the committee, but is not currently moving forward with fund distribution.
    - Reimbursement of funds spent on this project already may be a problem.
    - Assessments done by Digital Sandbox and are waiting for results.
  - \$800,000 for med surge – not yet approved by committee.
- Volunteer Database: Medical Reserve Corps, CERT, etc., would recruit, train and maintain database through crisis center.
- Hospital Training/ ICS:
  - ICS 400 available at end of March through St. Pete College.
  - ICS 100, 200 and 700 classes are available from Steve Lecroy

## **Committee Reports:**

- Radiological:
  - Working on voice annunciators – will be installed at ACH by next meeting (\$150 each).
  - Gary Frank to contact Edward White Hospital.
  - Ambulances do not carry any type of radiation monitors.

## **New Business:**

- Ready Alert:
  - County is doing a system clean-up to streamline the Ready Alert process.

  - Each agency can create it's own agency group and can then send messages to those people.
- Mass Casualty Exercise:
  - Exercise is March 21 and 22.
  - Scene meeting was held and still looking for objectives.
  - Final copy of drill manual by 03/09/07.
- Hospital Elevation:
  - TBRPC provided elevation data – Emergency Management will communicate with TBRPC about who will evacuate.
  - May need to form new partnerships.
  - Each hospital should submit their lowest elevation point to Dave Macnamee.
