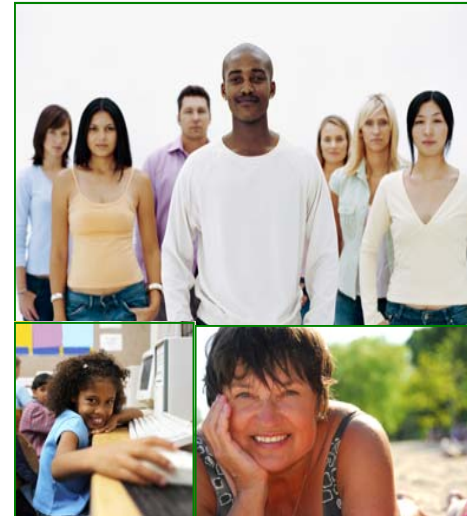

The Pinellas County Uninsured Health Care Collaborative offers medical homes for the uninsured. In order to qualify you must:

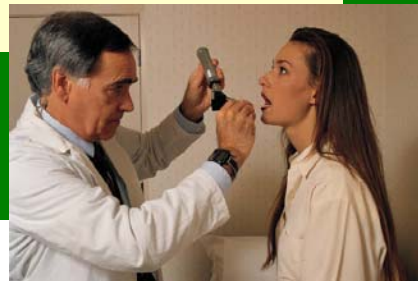
- ◆ Have no health insurance
- ◆ Be a Pinellas County resident
- ◆ Be between the ages of 18-64
- ◆ Be an U.S. citizen, legal permanent resident or sponsored alien
- ◆ Bring pay stub for proof of income.
- ◆ Have documentation to prove the above (Examples: birth certificate, Social Security card, rental lease or utility bills)

Community Outreach Program for Uninsured

- ◆ For any person who does not have insurance.
- ◆ A nurse will provide a health assessment for you and help you to find a medical home.
- ◆ Help with applying for affordable insurance if you work.
